Students who are certified medically unfit to take the Weighted Assessments will be recorded as "absent with valid reason". They must submit the **original copy** of the Medical Certificate from authorised medical practitioners to their respective Form Teacher when they return to school after their medical leave. No make-up assessments will be conducted for students who are absent on the day of the weighted assessment.
